

Kempton Power Pulls Light Farm Stock Rules

- I. ALL DRIVERS AND TRACK HELPERS MUST SIGN A WAIVER OF LIABILITY. SAFETY IS FIRST AND FOREMOST, AND WHEELIE BARS ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED ON ALL TRACTORS. No tractor will be turned away for safety equipment!
2. 18.4-38 max tire size for all classes, NO CUT TIRES, all tires must be pneumatic rubber tires.
3. 20" hitch height, minimum 18" behind centerline of rear axle, hitch holes must be minimum 3"x3.75" and minimum of ½" thick, and hitch deemed unsafe will not be allowed to pull. NO FLOATING HITCHES & NO CLEVISES
4. Classes 4500-6500 lbs will be limited to 3.5 mph, 7500-9500 will run at 6mph Fenders required for 1965 and newer tractors
5. Naturally aspirated tractors only, no turbos. Detroit diesel 2 strokes may run with a factory blower.
6. Flagman has final say on the track, driver must stop when red flagged.
7. Registration closes half hour prior to start time. Pulling order to be determined the day of. Drivers meeting will be approximately 15 minutes before start time.
8. RPM's limited to 3,000 rpm's
9. No riders!
10. Gas, diesel, and LP only permissible fuels
11. Shirt, pants, and closed toed shoes must be worn when pulling.
12. Weights may not extend beyond rear tires. All weights to be safely secured on brackets, or bolted solid, no weights on seat or operators platform
13. 2 hook limit, may allow more the day of depending on tractor turnout
14. 100 lbs weight allowance for scale variance, all tractors must rescale after pulling.
Any decision made the day of will supersede these posted rules.
Class list- 4,500 - 5,000 - 5,500 - 6,000 - 6,500 - 7,500 - 8,500 - 9,500
Hook fee will be \$20/hook, with a yearly \$10 insurance fee for each driver
